PROGRAM OF STUDY FOR A MINOR IN BIOLOGY

Students must complete 15-18 hours of Biology related work with at least 12-16 hours of upper division biology course work. Each course must be a minimum of three credit hours. The program must include 4 courses from at least two different departments including Biology. Only 4 hours of research can count towards the 12-16 hours in the Biology Minor. None of the upper level Biology courses can be used to fulfill both a Major and Minor requirement nor can they be used to fulfill two different Minor program's requirements. All upper level biology courses must be taken in residence.

Students must choose 4 courses from at least two of the following pre-fixes.

- BIOL** (except 3240L, 3590, 4940)
- BCMB** (any course)
- CBIO** (except 3100)
- ECOL** (**effect. Fall 2004**) (except 3400, 3070, 4271, 4930, 4931, 4940, 4990-(H), 3590 or any other pre-fix they are cross-listed with)
- ENTO** (only 3140, 3650, 4000, 4010, 4200, 4400, 4260, 4261, 4400, 4820)
- GENE** (any course)
- MARS** (only 3450, 4200, 4380, 4500, 4620, 4810)
- MIBO** (3500 or higher)
- PBIO** (except PBIO 3450(-H), 3440, 3240L, 3650)
- PSYC** (only 4120, 4130, 5750, 5770, 5850)
- VPHY** (3100)

BIOL 3900, 3900H, all reading, Independent study, and Internship courses are not allowed.
Each course must be a minimum of 3 credit hours.
